Summer Climate

These conditions seem to be coming by with more frequency every year. Associated with them are increased range grasses stress levels, dry soils, moisture loss and habitat loss. That's not to mention the ripple effect that it has on the live cattle market along the state. Concerned yet? Please prey, sing, dance, turn on a candle, anything to bring some rain to Brooks County and Texas.

What Can YOU Do?

Planning for tomorrow is integral to a successful rancher. As the summer approaches, we have to anticipate what the forecasted climate can do to our operations. It might be too late but saving an emergency pasture could help in the short run. Make sure you are on a sustainable stocking rate according to your pounds of grass per acre and give supplemental nutritive feed to fulfill dietary requirements. Other options are culling the herd. Start with the older momma cows; follow with the less productive/more susceptible to health issues cattle and hope that number will be enough. If none of these are options, the
