The Texas A&M AgriLife and Healthy South Texas offers “Well Informed” screenings to help private well owners manage their wells. This event will provide an opportunity to screen water samples for nitrates, total dissolved solids, *E. coli* and coliform bacteria. If the water is used as a drinking water source, the samples will also be screened for arsenic. The screening is presented by Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service in partnership with the AgriLife Extension office in Brooks County.

Instructions & Dates

Collecting a sample

- Open and drain a new, sealed, 16.9oz water bottle and use it to collect water sample from the nearest faucet to the water well.
- Try your best to prevent cross contamination (dirt, other fluids)
- Sample must be collected within 24hrs from drop off date.

Drop Off // Aug. 1st

- Drop off at the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service office in Brooks County, 219 Calixto Mora Ave., Courthouse Annex in Falfurrias, TX

Results // Aug. 10th

- Screening results may be picked up this date at the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service office in Brooks County, 219 Calixto Mora Ave., Courthouse Annex in Falfurrias, TX
